



Janusz Korczak PRIZE for GLOBAL SOUTH

A stipend programme funded by the Rector of Maria Grzegorzewska University

In 2020 the stipend covers participation in the 13th UNESCO Janusz Korczak Chair International Summer School that will take place at the Maria Grzegorzewska University in Warsaw; 14-18.09.2020

Thematic:

"In Korczak's footsteps (Korczak's heritage and philosophy of education)"

Stipends Include: tuition, course certificate, accommodation and subsistence in Warsaw, Poland. The stipend will also cover flights up to 500 euro.

Exclude: VISA & Health Insurance (a letter of invitation will be provided to aid the VISA process but the VISA has to be organized and paid for by the participant)

How to apply:

Please send an essay or an academic paper of 4500-6500 words highlighting the relevance of Janusz Korczak's educational philosophy or socio-cultural heritage in your own country of origin or the current setting you live in. Please include an abstract and keywords, an Introduction, Discussion and Conclusions followed by References. Please write in English.

The thematic may include: children's rights, child participation, migration, ethnic and religious conflicts and dialogue, education for peace, gender equity, discrimination... and more, as long as it is linked somehow to Korczak's life or his writings.

Please keep in mind that Janusz Korczak contributed to the development of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and authored multiple books for children as well as academic contributions or diaries. Either of these may serve as a link relevant today.

Evaluation:

A transparent academic commission comprising of 5 independent judges including a pupil, a student, a school teacher, a doctor and a professor, will evaluate the applications based on the merit of the work and the quality. We envisage 2 separate Categories: essays and academic papers but if there are more applications for a single category, both prizes may be granted in the same category.

All papers must be written in English, adhere to ethical standards of quoting other sources and contain references. All papers must be unpublished works and the applicant must be the author. Confirmation of authorship will be required and an anti-plagiarism software will be used for automatic verification. The best papers and essays will be published in a peer-reviewed journal or a book. Please sign the authorship form and send it together with your work.

Eligibility criteria:

A contestant must be 18 or over and a citizen of the global South. They need to be either enrolled for a university course or be a university graduate at any stage of their career.

Contestants representing economic category C will be given 10 extra points in their evaluation sheets. To check what countries represent category C economy: <https://www.isa-sociology.org/en/membership/table-of-economies-by-category>

Place of study: Majority of course activities will be based at the Maria Grzegorzewska University in Warsaw, field workshops in institutions located in the city of Warsaw.
