MARIA GRZEGORZEWSKA (1888-1967) — WAS A VOICE FOR THE RIGHTS OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES AND A PIONEER OF SPECIAL EDUCATION IN POLAND

JANUSZ KORCZAK (1878-1942) – A VOICE FOR CHILDREN'S RIGHTS, PEDIATRICIAN, EDUCATOR, WRITER, JOURNALIST, RESEARCHER OF CHILDHOOD.

Our Interdisciplinary Doctoral School teaches social sciences: psychology, pedagogy and sociology.

PhD candidates are recruited once a year in an open competition. There are no tuition fees and doctoral candidates receive a special bursary. The aim of the doctoral school is to support the personal and professional development of researchers on their way to scientific independence. The final objective is a doctoral thesis prepared under the supervision of experienced tutors and dedicated thesis supervisors.





Library

Our well-equipped library takes up whole floor in one of the campus main buildings. The library provides access to 146 000 of books (including 700 volumes in English) and articles in over 100 journal titles available in hard copy. The library offers access to Elsevier, Springer, Wiley, EBSCO (PsycINFO, PsycEXTRA, PsycTests, Education Source), Nature, Science, Web of Science, IBUK Libra PWN, IBUK Libra Light PWN. The library takes part in the Academica programme of exchanging resources with other academic libraries.

It stores 40 000 MA, bachelor and PhD thesis. It provides open access repositories and a large quantity of e-books.










Ongoing Development


