ORDER No. 8/2021 of the Head of Doctoral School of the Maria Grzegorzewska University of 22 December 2021

on the procedure for submitting a doctoral dissertation at the Doctoral School

Pursuant to § 12(7) of the Regulations of the Doctoral School of the Maria Grzegorzewska University, adopted by Resolution No. 138/2019 of the Senate of the University of 20 March 2019 on the adoption of the Regulations of the Doctoral School run by the Maria Grzegorzewska University, as amended, the consolidated text of which constitutes Appendix No. 1 to Resolution No. 155/2021 of the Senate of the University of 28 April 2021, I order as follows:

§ 1

- 1) A doctoral student's education at the Doctoral School ends with the submission of a doctoral dissertation.
- 2) The doctoral dissertation presents the candidate's general theoretical knowledge in the discipline or disciplines and the ability to conduct scientific work independently.
- 3) The subject of the doctoral dissertation is an original solution to a scientific problem, an original solution to the application of the results of one's own scientific research in the social sphere.
- 4) A doctoral dissertation can be a written work, including a scientific monograph, a collection of published and thematically related scientific articles, a project, implementation work, as well as an independent and isolated part of a collective work. The doctoral dissertation can be prepared in Polish or English.
- 5) The doctoral student submits their doctoral dissertation, together with an abstract in Polish and English and a supervisor's opinion, to the Head of the Doctoral School within the deadline specified in the Individual Research Plan.

The Order comes into force on the date it is signed.
