# ACCOMODATION

# MEDICAL CARE



#### **EU/EEA CITIZENS**

Poland has the health care system based on general health insurance. Persons covered by the general health insurance are entitled to free health services in the territory of Poland at the health care providers who have concluded contracts with the National Health Fund.

#### NON EU/EEA CITIZENS

The students from non-EU/EEA countries should purchase health insurance in their home country, before departure. In case of the ISIC or Euro < 26, insurance is included in the card and the student does not need to buy another one unless he/she wants to increase its scope or value. Erasmus students (having so called legitymacja studencka - student's card - issued by the host university) are usually allowed to consult doctors at academic medical care centres.
