- an icon of teacher training,

Our Roots

MARIA GRZEGORZEWSKA (1888-1967) – WAS A VOICE FOR THE RIGHTS OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES AND A PIONEER OF SPECIAL EDUCATION IN POLAND

JANUSZ KORCZAK (1878-1942) – A VOICE FOR CHILDREN'S RIGHTS, PEDIATRICIAN, EDUCATOR, WRITER, JOURNALIST, RESEARCHER OF CHILDHOOD.

Our Interdisciplinary Doctoral School teaches social sciences: psychology, pedagogy and sociology.

PhD candidates are recruited once a year in an open competition. There are no tuition fees and doctoral candidates receive a special bursary. The aim of the doctoral school is to support the personal and professional development of researchers on their way to scientific independence. The final objective is a doctoral thesis prepared under the supervision of experienced tutors and dedicated thesis supervisors.



Library

Our well-equipped Library in its current form is located in two buildings on the Campus. The modern Reading Room (building D) with comfortable individual and group work areas offers on-site use of books, journals, APS theses, APS dissertations and databases, as well as computer workstations and scanners. The Lending Library (Building B) provides access to more than 145,000 books (including more than 700 volumes in English).

The library offers access to databases from Elsevier, Springer, Taylor&Francis, Wiley, EBSCO (PsycINFO, PsycEXTRA, PsycTests, APA PsycTherapy, Education Source Ultimate), Nature, Science, Web of Science, as well as e-books in the IBUK Libra PWN and Legimi services.

The Library participates in Academica, a digital interlibrary loan program, and in the Warsaw Lending System giving access to the resources of other academic libraries.

In the Library, workstations are prepared for people with disabilities and text assistive devices are available.



Ongoing Development

We are in the process of building new modern facilities at our campus. The plan of the new learning and research spaces reflects our ongoing growth from a specialist higher education facility into an academic hub of sciences dedicated to human development, social inclusion, human rights and children's rights.




