Ordinance No 411/2022 of the Rector of the Maria Grzegorzewska University of the 15th November 2022

on determining additional admissions and the schedule of additional admissions 2022/2023 for the newly established *Master's in Children's Rights and Childhood Studies* (MICRACS) full-time second-cycle studies. In accordance with article 23 sec. 1 of the act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as later amended) and pursuant to § 1 sec. 5 and 7 of the Resolution No 156/2021 of the Maria Grzegorzewska University Senate of 28 April 2021, the consolidated text of which constitutes Annex A to Resolution No 336/2022 of the Maria Grzegorzewska University Senate of 16 March 2022, and pertaining to the matter of the justified case involving the failure to meet the admissions limit for the newly established *Master's in Children's Rights and Childhood Studies* (MICRACS), full-time second-cycle studies, I order the following:

§ 1

- I hereby appoint additional admissions for the Master's in Children's Rights and Childhood Studies (MICRACS), full-time second-cycle studies, starting from the summer semester 2022/2023 under the conditions set out in Resolution No 156/2021 of the Maria Grzegorzewska University Senate of 28 April 2021, the consolidated text of which constitutes Annex A to Resolution No 336/2022 of the Maria Grzegorzewska University Senate of 16 March 2022.
- The 2022/2023 additional admissions schedule for the newly established Master's in Children's Rights and Childhood Studies (MICRACS) full-time studies is attached as an Appendix to this Ordinance.
